The Department of Water Supply invites all teachers to enter their students' artwork in its 11th Annual Water Conservation Poster Contest. The contest is open to Maui County public, private and home-schooled students from kindergarten to 8th grade. Every student who creates and submits an entry will receive a Certificate of Participation.

Poster Contest Guidelines

Eligibility

Any student, from Kindergarten through Grade 8 in Maui County.

Rules

1. All entries must reflect the theme of the contest as it relates to **DRINKING WATER**.
2. One entry per student. No collaborative work.
3. All entries must be drawn horizontally (landscape) on 11"x17" white paper.
4. ART MEDIA: any media except chalk, charcoal, and oil based crayon, in single or mixed media will be accepted. Students should use large lettering and only few words. Strong colors and heavy lines show the best.
5. Only original artwork will be accepted. Posters containing computer-generated graphics, photographs, collages or 3-D art work will not be eligible for consideration.
6. Entries with identification on the artwork side of the poster will be disqualified.
7. Entries must be submitted flat, not rolled.
8. Entries must have important point (s) about water conservation.
9. Entries must be accompanied by one completed entry form.
10. Teachers—Please submit a list of correctly spelled names of participating students.

Judging Criteria

- Water conservation message
- Originality
- Visual effectiveness (creativity and artistic ability)

Competition Levels

Kindergarten Grades 1/2 Grades 3/4 Grades 5/6 Grades 7/8

Prizes

All winning posters will be featured in the 2021 DWS Water Conservation Calendar. A total of 15 prizes will be awarded with first, second and third prizes presented to winners in each competition level. Three honorable mentions from each category will also receive prizes. Winners will also receive Certificates of Recognition.
