

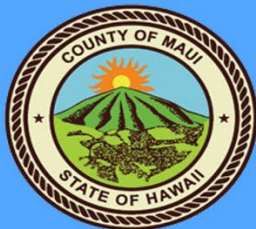

The Department of Water Supply invites Maui County students to share their knowledge and express their creativity through its 12<sup>th</sup> Annual Water Conservation Poster Contest. This year students attending public, private, charter schools or home-schooled in Maui County will have the opportunity to create original art that reflects the theme, “**Conserving Water, *Our Kuleana***”.

## **RULES AND GUIDELINES**

### **ELIGIBILITY**

- Participants must be in Kindergarten to 5<sup>th</sup> Grade
- Open to all public, private, charter schools or home-schooled students in Maui County

### **ENTRIES**

- Artwork must be original and have the current theme incorporated into the poster (preferably as the header/title).
- Entries must have important point(s) about water conservation.
- One entry per student - No collaborative work.
- All entries must be drawn horizontally (landscape) on 11” x 17” white paper.
- ART MEDIA: any media EXCEPT chalk, charcoal and oil-based crayon, in single or mixed media.
- Posters must be the original artwork of the student. Entries containing computer-generated graphics, photographs, collages or 3-D artwork will not be eligible for consideration.
- Entries with identification on the artwork side of the poster will be disqualified.
- Posters must be submitted flat, not rolled or folded.
- Entries must be accompanied by the official entry form on the back of the poster.

## JUDGING

- Posters will be judged based on creativity in interpreting the contest theme, accuracy of information, originality and adherence to guidelines.
- A panel of judges will review the entries and select poster winners from each of the following categories:

First Category: Kindergarten – Grade 1  
Second Category: Grades 2 – 3  
Third Category: Grades 4 – 5

## TIMELINE

- Entries will be accepted through **Friday, March 10, 2023 by 4:30 P.M.**
- Contest Winners Award Recognition Ceremony – TBD

## PRIZES

- There will be 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners in each grade category and 3 honorable mentions.
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Place Winners: \$ 200 Gift Card
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Place Winners: \$150 Gift Card
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Place Winners: \$100 Gift Card
  - Honorable Mentions: \$ 75 Gift Card
- All winners will receive a Certificate of Recognition from the Mayor and the County Council.
- All students who submit entries will receive a Certificate of Participation from the Director of the Department of Water Supply.
